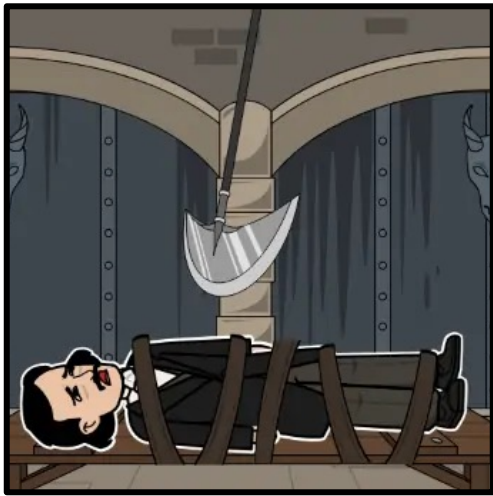
Unless someone like you cares a whole awful lot,/ nothing is going to get better. It's not. (5) *b. 1904*

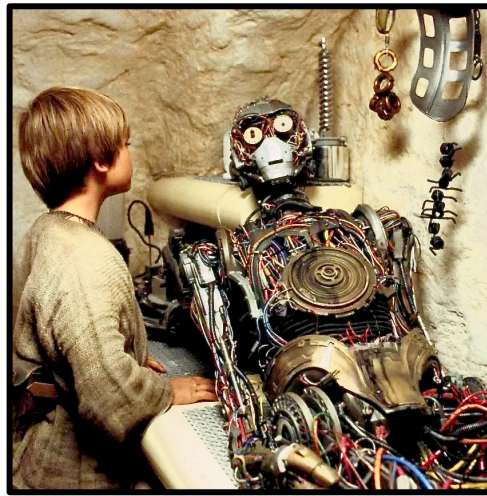
Old age should burn and rave at close of day;/ Rage, rage against the dying of the light. (6) *b. 1914*

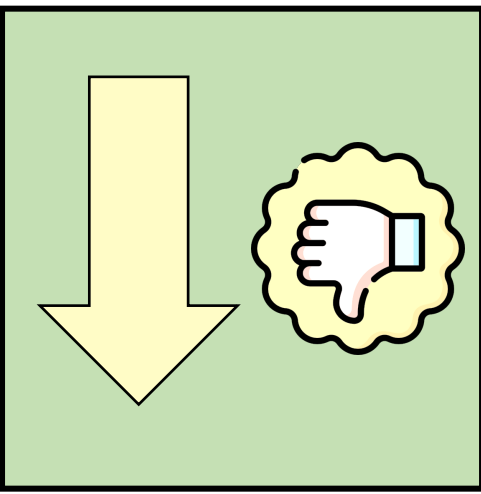

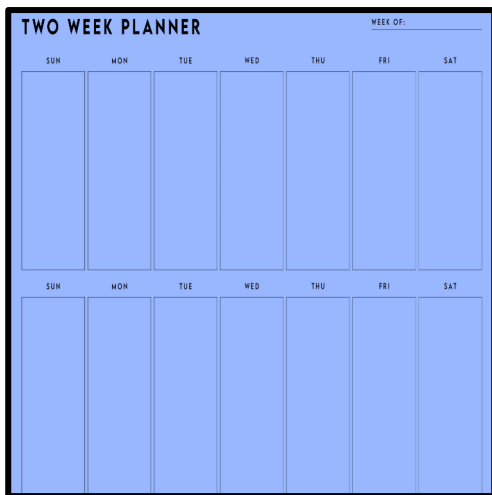

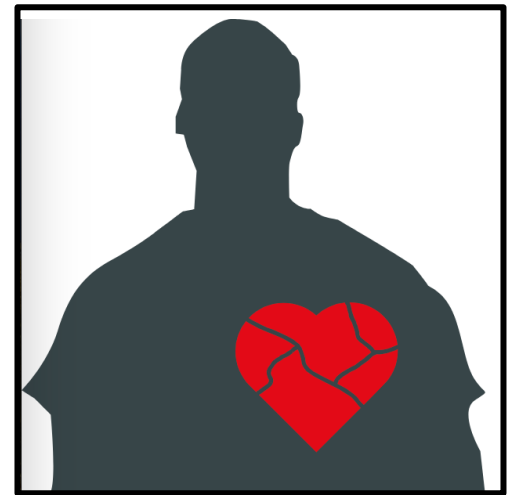
