- Day Two: Practical advice for collaborating at a distance, including topics ranging from use of Venue Client features to mitigating the impact of time zones. Participants will create virtual working groups to explore possibilities for collaboration.
- Day Three: Meetings of virtual working groups, followed by reports back and workshop closure. Participants will be encouraged to continue their virtual working groups, using Access Grid and other online resources.
